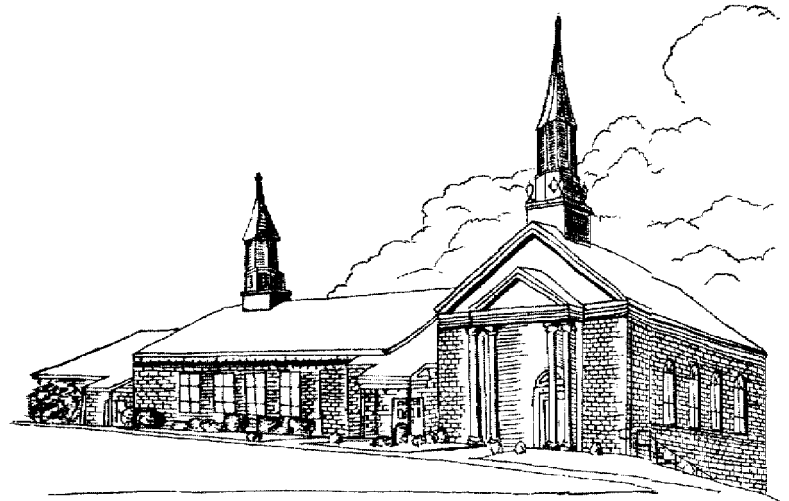
Our prayer person this week is Kim Miller.
