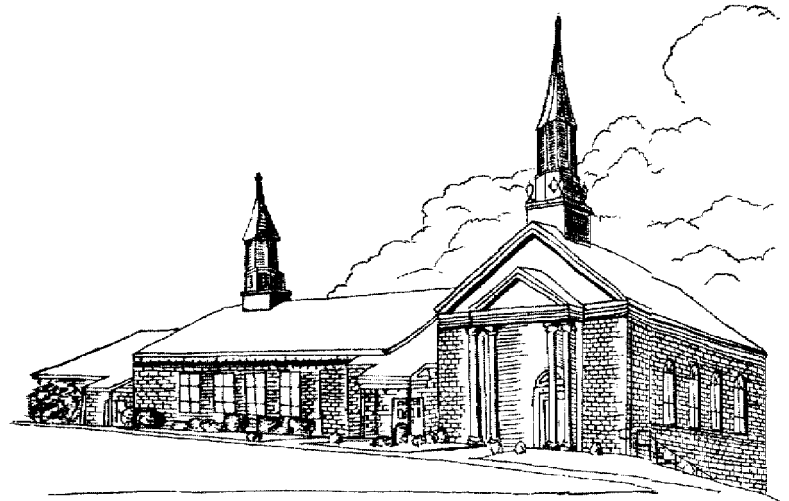
Our organist, Betty Cauley, is ready to retire. If you know of someone who would be interested in our organist/pianist position, please see Charles Clemmer.
