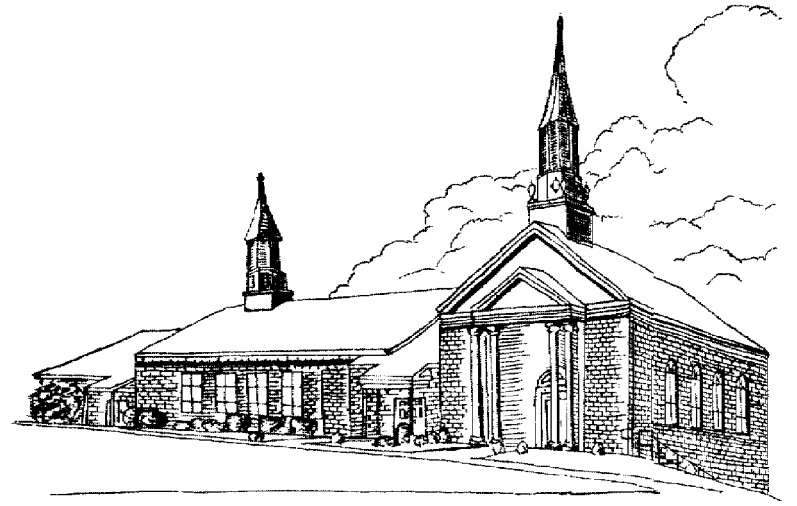
Our prayer person this week is Judy Swann.
